Abstract format: 5 in (wide) x 4 in (high)
 12 pt font
 Line 1 – title
 Line 2 – author(s)
 Line 3 – affiliation(s)
 Line 4 – start abstract text

Poster boards: 6 ft (wide) x 4 ft (high)
